

When I became a high school student, I was shy* and could not talk with other students. So I was happy when one of my classmates, Masaki, talked to me. He said, "Shall we join the dance* club? I've decided to join the club because I enjoyed dancing in P.E.* class in junior high school." I remembered that I also enjoyed the P.E. dance class. So I joined the club with him.

In June, our club danced at a high school dance festival. Masaki and I danced in front of many people for the first time. I was very nervous.* Even standing in front of people was a big thing for me. I could not look at the people. I just tried to move like the other students.

When we were ① the dances of other schools, Masaki said to me, "Look at that boy! His dancing is so good." He was right. The boy's movements* were very fast. We wanted to be like him, so we talked to him after the festival. His name was Ryota. Masaki said to him, "Can you teach us how to practice?" He taught us some ways to practice. We began to visit his school on weekends and practice with the students of his club. It was good to make new friends and talk with them about dancing.

In my English textbook for the second year, there was a story about a Japanese dancer.* His name was Shingo Amano. He went to America to study dancing and practiced hard there. He became a popular dancer and he danced at a concert of a famous singer.

After reading the story, I thought, " I sent the question to Mr. Amano on his blog.* I was very happy when he answered me. He wrote, "I needed some time to think about it. I worried because I could not speak English well at that time. But I thought that we don't need a language when we dance. So I decided to go. I learned to speak English by talking about dancing with other dancers there." I also asked him, "Do you feel nervous in front of many people?" He answered, "Of course I feel nervous, but I always try to remember what I want to express* through my dance. Please remember that you can express something by dancing." I thought that was true.

At the dance festival last month, our club tried a different kind of dance. We tried to express the joy* of spring. People usually express it through language, but we tried to express it only through dance. We thought about movements to express new life.* We sometimes moved fast and sometimes moved slowly. After our dance, Ryota came to me and said, "You danced very well. I understood what you wanted to express." I remembered Mr. Amano's words on the blog. He wrote, "I feel happy when people understand the message of my dance." I was happy, too.

I think dancing has ② me. I was shy, but now I enjoy talking with people. I still feel nervous but I like dancing in front of other people. Now I can feel the joy of expressing myself. Dancing has helped me to find a new part of myself. I want to thank Masaki, Ryota, and Mr. Amano.

Karen: I also want to know about the agreement, but I'm going to go back to Australia soon.




